- SUBJECT: **The William Earl Bowers Memorial Scholarship**
(S.A.M.E. Scholarship Program)
- PURPOSE: To encourage and assist qualified students who wish to pursue a college education in the field of engineering, mathematics, or science so that they, in turn, might further the goals and exemplify the ideals of S.A.M.E.
- TERMS: One \$4,000 scholarship for academic year **2010-2011**
Application, transcript, and letters of reference must be received no later than 14 May 2010. No exceptions.
- ELIGIBILITY: --Son/daughter or grandson/granddaughter or stepson/stepdaughter of an active or deceased member of the Huntsville Post, S.A.M.E., or an active student member of the Huntsville Post, S.A.M.E.
- College freshman or sophomore while scholarship is in effect.
- Full-Time student
- Accepted by an accredited college or university.
- Minimum high school grade point average of 3.0 or college freshman grade point average of 2.5.
- Can only win \$4,000 scholarship once.
- SELECTION CRITERIA: --Required major in engineering, mathematics, or natural science.
- Evidence of serious scholastic attitude, good character, leadership qualities, and well-rounded personal development. (**3 references**)
- Preference to student with military aspirations as exemplified by enrollment in Officer Training program but military aspirations is not a requirement.
- 2010 SCHEDULE:** --**May 14** - Deadline for **receipt** of applications

--**May 15 - June 7** - Review of applications, selection and personal interviews of top applicants (if applicable), and selection of winner.

--**June 17** - Presentation of scholarship at June Post meeting.
